 **New Bank Account:** The new operational bank account for St Andrews New Kirk is now open and details of what to do regarding changing standing order payments to the new account are on the green sheet available in all 3 church buildings along with a standing order mandate if you are not able to change your standing order yourself online. Although payments will still be received and transferred from the old church accounts, at some point it would be good if old standing orders are cancelled and new ones set up. The name St Andrews New Kirk is sometimes followed by 'operational' or 'community', both of which are acceptable.

### **Regular reminders:**

  **The Fair Trade stall** runs after the worship at St Leonard's and, on request, elsewhere! They often have new products to try as well as the staples, such as coffee and chocolate! When you buy from the stall you support farmers in fragile communities across the world. If you can't get to a St Leonard's service, please message the office and I will put you in touch with Mary who organises the stall to make alternative arrangements.

 **Easyfundraising:** This has been a great source of 'free' money for Cameron and St Leonard's. Until our new New Kirk bank account is operational we are still operating under the St Leonard's banner, but be assured the money will still go to the New Kirk.
